Saturday, June 27 10 a.m. – 6 p.m.

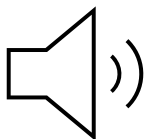
Sunday, June 28 11:30 a.m. – 6 p.m.

Throughout the 1700 and 1800s, Indigenous peoples, independent and company fur traders would gather in the summer months to trade goods and resupply. Step back in time and explore this living history camp from the late 1700s, meet the fur traders and learn about their way of life. Check the camp information board for additional activities.

History of Pine Fort Walking Tour

Saturday, June 27 and Sunday, June 28 2 p.m. – 3 p.m.

Join a Park Interpreter for a 1.5 km walk outside the visitor centre and day-use area to explore the story of the Pine Fort and early trade in the region. Participants will have an opportunity to taste pemmican, a traditional food and important trade good.



Sensory Alert – Loud Noise: cannons and muzzleloaders will be fired on Friday at 6:45 p.m. Cannons may be fired on the hour between 10 a.m. – 5 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. Muskets and muzzleloaders may be fired at any time between the posted hours.
